PRICED VOCABULARY OF MILITARY CLOTHING AND NECESSARIES.

(Published in accordance with A.M.R. & O. 1330.)

1. The rates quoted in this edition of the "Priced Vocabulary of Military Clothing and Necessaries" will govern the charges for all issues on payment, unless otherwise directed, and will be the basis for charges for articles lost, damaged or destroyed by neglect. In the case of articles issued on payment or charged against individuals, the source of replacement of which is the United Kingdom, the rate of exchange current at date of sale or loss will be added to the rates shown herein. When articles are purchased direct from the Commonwealth Government Clothing Factory the prices quoted herein should be taken as a guide only, and are subject to variation by the Clothing Factory without notice.

2. The prices for clothing materials (Section 7) are not intended to govern sales to Government Contractors, as special rates are arranged in these cases, but sales to private firms for use on other than Government orders will be made at the prices shown herein, plus $2\frac{1}{2}$ per cent and sales tax, and exchange where applicable.

3. The designations in the first column have been made as short and distinctive as possible, and will generally be sufficient for use in ledger headings, requisitions, vouchers and returns, but if in any particular instance this is not so, additional information should be added to identify the service for which the article is required. The sectional arrangement of the articles must also be adhered to when requisitioning stores on the Ordnance Branch.

4. Each article has in addition been assigned a "Catalogue Number". This number will be quoted on all packages taken from stock for transit by boat or rail in lieu of markings showing nomenclature. The quantity, sizes of contents and, when necessary, the number of bale, will be shown. For example, bale No. 20, containing 50 Service Dress Jackets, size 10, will be marked thus :-

6. Articles which are not of current manufacture, the existing stock of which will not be replaced, are shown in italics.
